Know what pony needs in its paddock to make it comfortable (water, shade, grass)		
Know what a pony eats and drinks		
Identify parts of the horse (nostril, mane, wither, forelock, knee, flank, ears, forehead)		
Identify colours and markings (chestnut, brown/bay, grey – star, sock, blaze)		
Know how to wipe dust and mud off saddlery and clean bit
