

APPLICATION FOR C * EXAMINATION



This application must be lodged with your Zone C* Co-ordinator (or Club C* Coordinator/ Chief Coach if your zone does not have a Zone C* Coordinator). The Zone C* Coordinator is responsible for liaising with the State C* Coordinator (coaching@ponyclubwa.asn.au) prior to an exam date being set.

NOTE: If not enough candidates are ready in your Zone, it may be possible to do it in conjunction with another Zone. The State C* Coordinator will be able to advise and coordinate.

C* Examination Application Fee

The C* Examination Application fee will be set by the Zone and paid to Zone. The minimum recommended fee is \$35 per candidate.

Riders will need to check what fee will be charged by Zone to cover costs of examination (Examiner Fees & Travel costs) Fees may vary between Zones depending number of candidates and Examiners required. The Zone will advise if payment of an examination fee is required to be sent in with your application, or delayed until a later date when specific costs are known, and an appropriate fee can be worked out.

In order to keep costs down for candidates, Zones may look at subsidising fees through fundraising efforts or grants.
