## Conditions of Entry

1. **Entries:** Entries are via the My Pony online entry system. An online entry denotes full acceptance of the terms and conditions of entry. Entries close on Tuesday 2 June 2020 at 10pm unless classes are filled prior.
2. **Rules:** This event will be run in accordance with the current EA National Dressage Rules and the Pony Club WA rules for Dressage including the Pony Club WA Gear Checking rules. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of and to comply with the rules at all times.
3. **Event emails:** Please direct all event queries via email to [dressage@ponyclubwa.asn.au](mailto:dressage@ponyclubwa.asn.au)
4. **Eligibility of Riders:** Classes are open to Pony Club WA and Pony Club WA Open Riders and will be run under Pony Club WA Insurance only. You will need to provide your Pony Club WA membership details as part of your online entry. Rider age is as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020.
5. **Attire of Riders:** Pony Club WA riders must wear their Pony Club uniform. Pony Club WA Open Riders are to wear either hacking jackets or neat casual attire with long sleeves. All other gear is to be in accordance with the Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual.
6. **Turnout of Mount:** Neat and tidy presentation - no need to plait for this competition.
7. **Arena:** The arena does not need to be a "professional competition arena". It needs to be a 60m x 20m area with poles or cones to portray the sidelines. The "letters" can be cones or buckets or pot plants to enable the Judges to see the markers. Riders may choose to start their test from inside the arena.
8. **Gear Check:** At the conclusion of the test the rider must ride straight over to the camera person and be filmed all around the horse and rider to show their gear is compliant.
9. **Disclaimer of Liability:** By entering in this event or activity, I agree that my gear will be checked by my parent or myself (if over 18yrs) to ensure it complies with Pony Club WA safety and sport requirements. Neither the Organising Committee, nor Pony Club Western Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
10. **Refunds and Scratchings:** After the close of entries a medical or veterinary certificate is required to be emailed to the committee as per the [State Competition General Regulations](#).
11. **Guidelines for Videoing:**
  - The person who is videoing the test must stand approximately 1 metre directly behind the letter E and directly in line with the letter B. Videos are to be taken in one continuous recording (per test). They must NOT be edited and no special effects, enhancements or music is to be added.
  - Ensure video sound is ON.
  - If videoing on a smart phone please ensure you film in **Landscape orientation**.
  - Zooming is allowed but you must try to make sure that you can see the entire horse and rider at all times. Try to include half the width of the arena at all times so the Judge gets a clear view for accuracy.
  - Tests are welcome to be called and the caller should stand at B. Their instructions must be clearly heard on the video.
  - After the final salute the rider is to ride the horse directly over to the video person and show both sides of the horse and rider before concluding filming. This is for gear check and welfare purposes.
  - Please review your video to ensure that all movements in the test can be clearly seen by the judge.
  - Upload your video to YouTube as an "Unlisted". The title of the video should use the Rider name, Horse name, Test and Event e.g. Harry Potter, Dobby, Prelim 1B (14-16 yrs), Pony Club WA Virtual Dressage Competition.
