#### **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

Horse/Rider combinations must have completed a minimum of two rallies as per the working rally definition at the club they are representing in the 12 months prior to close of entries AND be signed off as competent by the Club Chief Coach.

Clubs can apply for an exemption for Members who have not been able to qualify due to extenuating circumstances by emailing details of their circumstances to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au

#### **YARDS**

Serpentine Horse and Pony Club have a number of yards available for \$10 for the weekend.

Please make sure you leave your yards and the grounds clean and tidy.

Please ensure you only bring clean weed free hay.

All hay and manure need to be picked up and placed in designated areas before you leave on Sunday.

#### **CAMPING**

Camping is \$10 per family per night.

Camping is only allowed on the Polocrosse grounds (Serpentine town side of club house).

Horses must not be allowed to dig holes in the grassed oval area (e.g. when yarded in float yards)

Please place all your rubbish in the skip bins provided and leave your yards and camping area clean and tidy so we can come back to this wonderful location in the future.

#### **CANTEEN**

Will be open on both Saturday and Sunday.

#### **MORNING MEALS**

\$5 breakfasts from 7:00am Saturday and Sunday. Please fill out the Breakfast Request Form in the Entry Pack.

#### **EVENING MEALS**

An evening meal is available on Saturday night for \$15 per person. Please fill out the Dinner Request Form in the Entry Pack.

#### **JACKPOT BARREL**

There will be a Jackpot Barrel race held on Saturday afternoon. Entry on the day. Fee is **\$5.00 PER RUN**. Maximum of 2 runs per rider/pony combination.

#### **LEVIES**

A First Aid levy of \$15 per rider applies. The levy assists to cover the costs of having a qualified paramedic crew on duty for the entirety of the competition. The safety of our riders is a priority.

A compulsory ground fee of \$10 per horse applies to the weekend.

A compulsory Camping Fee of \$10 per night applies to families camping.

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

#### ENTRIES CLOSE FRIDAY 14th August 2020 at 5pm

- Entries must be returned in Excel format via email to activeriding@ponyclubwa.asn.au
- No faxed, late or incomplete entries will be accepted.
- The Chairperson and committee members do not have authority to accept/forward late entries.
- Entries must be completely and correctly filled out and lodged and must be endorsed appropriately.
- Each entry must have a completed Summary Sheet and signed Declaration Form.
- All payments including cost of entry, food and promotional material must be submitted with the Summary of Fees.
- Clubs/Zones will be invoiced once fees are checked.
- PPMG Team member nomination is a requirement with entry pack. This includes composite
  riders in composite teams as qualified in the Qualifier. An updated declaration form to be
  handed in at the briefing on Saturday morning if the team has changed since entering.

#### **RESERVATION OF RIGHT**

The State Active Riding Committee reserves the right to:

- cancel any class or event
- amend placing's dependant on class numbers
- divide any class
- transfer competitors between class
- alter the advertised times
- refuse any entry with a valid explanation

#### **TEAM MANAGERS**

- One Team Manager to be nominated for all age groups for all novelties on each day (i.e. one
  Zone Team Manager for all teams in all age groups on Saturday and one Zone Team Manager for
  all teams in all age groups on Sunday. not a separate Manager for each team) and MUST be
  nominated on the Team Manager/Helper Nomination Form.
- Pony Club Mount is to have one Zone Team Manager for all age groups and MUST be nominated on the Team Manager/Helper Nomination Form.
- Team Managers to whom a parent exemption does not apply MUST have a current Working with Children Check.

#### **HELPERS**

- Two Helpers from each Zone **MUST** be provided for each Novelty Event and **MUST** be nominated on the Team Manager/Helper Nomination Form.
- Two Helpers must be provided for each PPMG Team. These must consist of at least one line steward and one helper or two line stewards.
- The Helper MAY NOT be the same person as the Team Manager of ANY PPMG Team.
- If a Helper is not present prior to the event, that Team will not be permitted to compete.
- Volunteer helpers over the age of 18 that will be having contact with children in the line of their duty and to whom a parent exemption does not apply MUST have a current Working with Children Check.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS NOVELTIES**

For all Novelties including Pony Club Mount

- One horse, one rider rule will apply for Novelties.
- Horse and rider combinations must qualify as per the Working Rally Definition <u>Click Here</u>
   Rider's age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020. Qualifications must be gained prior to the close of entries.
- Each Club within a Zone may enter riders in each age group for the Zone Finals. The Horse/Rider combination to qualify in each age group as above.
- Zones may enter a maximum of THREE teams per age group, per event, excluding the Pony Club Mount, where only <u>ONE</u> Zone Team per age group will be accepted.
- The Zone Team in each section for the Championships will consist of the three best individual scores on the day of the Zone Finals or the riders with the highest scores who are able to attend the Championships.

#### **NOVELTY ENTRIES**

The Zone Team Nomination Forms are included in the Entry Spreadsheet.

Clubs will need to coordinate entries with their Zone Coordinator.

#### **NOVELTY SCORING**

The Champions will be the ZONE TEAM in each age group in the One Flag, Sword, Basketball, Diamond Flag and Wagon Wheel gaining the LOWEST total time (the fastest **two** times per team to count).

PONY CLUB MOUNT / ACTIVE RIDING CHALLENGE - the Champions will be the ZONE TEAM in each age group gaining the HIGHEST total score (ALL 3 team members' scores to count).

#### **HIGH POINT ZONE TEAMS**

A trophy will be awarded to the High Point Zone Team in each of the three age groups for the five Novelty events and Pony Club Mount/Active Riding Challenge. If a Zone has more than one team entered in an age group, each team will be counted separately; scores from Zone teams in the same age group will not be added together.

For the One Flag, Sword, Basketball, Diamond Flag and Wagon Wheel events- competitors must ride in their **FORMAL ZONE Uniforms**. If there are insufficient Zone Uniforms for all team members then formal club uniforms are allowed.

#### **DRESS - PONY CLUB MOUNT**

Pony Club Mount and Active Riding Challenge – competitors must ride in their formal Zone Uniforms.

#### **SADDLERY – NOVELTIES**

As per 2020 Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual and any subsequent amendments.

In particular please note:

- No whips or spurs allowed.
- A Snaffle Bridle, with an ordinary snaffle bit. A French Snaffle is acceptable.
- Badges are not allowed for any Active Riding activities.

#### **SADDLERY - PONY CLUB MOUNT**

As per 2020 Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual and any subsequent amendments.

In particular please note:

- No whips or spurs allowed.
- A Snaffle Bridle and Cavesson Noseband is preferred, with an ordinary snaffle bit. A French Snaffle is acceptable.
- Bridle must have a noseband made of the same material.
- NB: A Running or Irish Martingale and/or a Noseband other than a Cavesson is permitted but will be marked down.
- Pony Club Badge with efficiency disc is optional for PC Mount presentation however not wearing it will result in a loss of points in the presentation score.
