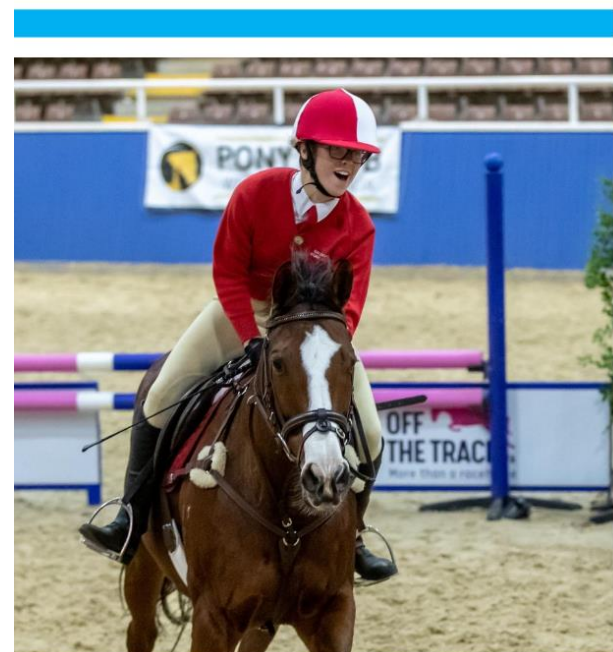

EXCITING CHANGES FOR 2020

- Consecutive heights can be ridden in the same class on the same day – but only 2 classes per day.
- 6 bar will be offered if time permits-payment on the day.
- Brigid Woss Equitation & Showjumping Team Event will be combined with Team Challenge to become the new class: Brigid Woss Equitation and Team Challenge.
- New Award: Best Presented on the day, sponsored by Western Hay.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR RIDERS AND PARENTS

OMNISPORT (My Pony)

- Make sure that you have your Pony Club number and password ready.
- Riders can now make any changes up to the close of entries on midnight 6 September 2020 or until classes are full.
Please choose carefully, as changes will not be made after this date unless Medical/Vet Certificate is provided.
- Riders can only ride two classes per day.

SWAPPING OF ENTRIES ON THE DAY:

There will NOT be swapping of classes or entries on the day for additional classes.

AWARDS

MICHELE WILKIE HIGH POINT EQUITATION PERPETUAL TROPHY

Awarded to the highest scoring individual rider in the Equitation round of the Showjumping Team Event

Equitation in Pony Club is the opportunity for riders and ponies to show good temperament and how well they work together. The riders and ponies are judged on uniform, equipment, general suitability for each other and it is the opportunity for the genuine pony clubber to achieve high places without having to jump high levels as rhythm, balance and pace are all considered.

BRIGID WOSS EQUITATION BURSARY

Ms Brigid Woss generously provides a bursary of \$500 awarded to first place; \$250 awarded to second place and a \$250 encouragement award. This class has two sections: Presentation and Equitation.

BRIGID WOSS

OFF THE TRACK

Awarded to eligible horses (registered TB or SB) that compete over the two days this information needs to be included on the additional information requested on "My Pony (Omnisport) entry. Placings will be given from 1st to 3rd.

All thoroughbreds and standardbreds bred for the purpose of racing qualify for the Off the Track Events and Clinics, and any of the classes we sponsor.

When entering you will be asked to provide your horses' race name and/or microchip. If you don't know these details, please describe their near side and offside brands for thoroughbreds or neck brand for standardbreds.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HORSES

Plaiting is not mandatory but is expected for the Brigid Woss Equitation Team Event.

Each horse or pony may only be ridden by one rider for the duration of the championships.

Horse/rider combinations CAN compete in more than one height in the same event format, except for the Brigid Woss/Team Challenge.

Horse/rider combinations can only compete in one round in each class, no HC available.

Horse/rider combinations must be competent at the height(s) that they have elected to enter.

Horse/rider combination can compete in no more than 2 classes per day. If a rider enters in more than 2 classes, they will only be permitted to ride in 2 classes per day and any additional round(s) payments will not be reimbursed.

A current height certificate maybe requested for riders competing in the Zone Team Pony Class – Riders under 13yrs on pony 14.2h and under. Please contact the Showjumping Committee if you require a height certificate.

PRESENTATIONS

Presentations for most classes will be mounted and will take place after the class in the arena.

GEAR CHECKING

All saddlery must comply with the current Pony Club WA Gear Checking Manual.

PLEASE BRING YOUR CURRENT GEAR EXEMPTION WITH YOU WHEN YOU PRESENT FOR GEAR CHECKING IF YOU HAVE ONE. Riders must be accompanied by the Team Manager for Gear Checking prior to the start of the team and zone competition.

FARRIER

There will be no official farrier on grounds over the weekend. If you need the services of a farrier, please call whomever you usually use.

VET

A Veterinary Clinic will be on call only. Any costs incurred will be the responsibility of the horse representative.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES AND MEDICATION CONTROL: It is illegal to utilise any Banned, Prohibited or Controlled medication. The use of such will result in elimination and other disciplinary action.

CANCELLATIONS, SCRATCHINGS OR ALTERATIONS

If for any reason you wish to withdraw from a class during the event, please inform the Event office as soon as possible. NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY OR SWAPPING OF CLASSES WILL BE PERMITTED. If you are withdrawing from a team, a form must be obtained from the event office and completed by the Team Manager. If your team has a duly qualified substitute, substitution forms will be available in the event office and must be completed by the Team Manager at least 30 minutes before the rider is scheduled to commence the class.

DISPUTES

Disputes must be lodged by the Team Manager for teams or Club representative for individuals, on an official form, that is available from the event office. This needs to be accompanied by \$50 and lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted. The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

TEAMS

Currently have composite team availability for riders competing at 90 & 105cm. If you are qualified and your club will endorse your application, please email State Showjumping Committee showjumping@ponyclubwa.asn.au

Camping

Camping is permitted on the grounds at the north/west area only as indicated. Day parking is at the south/west end. You must clean up and put your horses hay and poo in the concrete bins or take it home with you. Holes need to be filled in. There are 3 sided permanent metal yards available - you will need to bring your own gate. The yards can not be booked, so first come first serve.

INDIVIDUAL

Individual entries will be taken on My Pony (Omnisport) and are currently open.

CLUB TEAM ENTRIES

Currently there are some composite team positions availability for riders competing at 90 & 105cm. If you are qualified and your club will endorse your application, please email State Showjumping Committee showjumping@ponyclubwa.asn.au Cost is \$33.

INDIVIDUAL AND TEAM CLASSES

Riders are only allowed to compete in a maximum of 2 classes per day. This includes team and individual events so riders should only enter individual events if this fits into their total number of classes per day (Zone and Team Events are 1 class). Once the Individual entries are closed each pony club will be sent a list of riders that they need to complete the Declaration of Qualifications of two rallies for these riders and confirm that they have a signed disclaimer for each rider and that the horse and riders are competent at the level they have nominated. (Per COVID-19 State Championships Qualifications)

This needs to be returned to showjumping@ponyclubwa.asn.au on or before 14th September 2020.

Individual classes riders pay for their entries online at the time of entry.

ZONE TEAM ENTRIES

Are now closed.

GENERAL

- No late or incomplete entries will be accepted.
- The chairperson, committee members and office staff do **not** have authority to accept/forward late entries.
- All payments must be completed before close of entries—Proof of financial membership with Pony Club WA will be checked.

PREVIOUS ADVERTISED LEVIES

- Stables - \$15 per day (mandatory) transferred to Serpentine Ground Fee per day
- Locker - \$10 per day will be refunded to those who paid previously*
- Bunks - \$10 deposit for each key issue refunded to those who paid previously*
- Parking - \$6 will be transferred to First Aid levy, per day fee

Any additional days levies pre-paid* will be reimbursed, if not required for the current program.

*the amount will be minus the Credit Card fee that has already been debited.

SPORTS LEADERBOARDS

2020 Showjumping Leader board - Double Point Information

The following classes will receive double points at the 2020 State Showjumping Championships.

- AM7
- Super Two Phase.

No single points will be awarded to any other classes.

The following rules apply to receiving points

- *Single/Double point allocation **may be** allocated to specific classes at Pony Club WA State Championships.*
- *Only one test/class, per level, per day at an event will count toward the Sports Leader boards*
- *If more than one test/class, per level, per day is scheduled at an event placings will be awarded to:*
 1. *The class identified as the leader board class in the event entry pack.*
 2. *The highest placing per day per level, if a class has not been identified in the event entry pack.*
