Pony Club WA Selection Criteria

GENERAL CRITERIA

The following general criteria apply to all disciplines when selecting combinations for the National team.

- Riders must be a current financial member of Pony Club WA
- Ages taken from 1st January 2021
- Sub-juniors must have their D* certificate (by 1st June 2021)
- Juniors must have their C certificate (by 1st June 2021)
- Senior riders must have their C* or K certificate (by 30th June 2021)
- Riders must provide evidence of a clear training program and goal setting.
- Riders must have demonstrated fitness, rider experience and the ability to develop and maintain a consistent training program.
- Horse must be sound and fit to compete.
- Each PPMG team will consist of a total of five riders, Tetrathlon team total of 8 riders and all other discipline teams will consist of a total of 6 riders.
- Riders must demonstrate an acceptable level of behaviour, citizenship and horsemastership to be verified by club references.
- Pony Club WA Codes of Conduct must be signed before inclusion into the National team.
- Horse and Rider combinations must be qualified in accordance to the Working Rally Document 2018 in the 12 months prior to close of applications.
- Horse and Rider combinations must have qualified in accordance to the selection criteria.
- **For Dressage, Showjumping, Eventing and PPMG**
- In the 12 months prior to close of applications riders must be able to demonstrate skills at a minimum of 3 events at the appropriate level, Consideration maybe given for the qualifications to extend up to 18 months at the descension of the selection panel.
- **Tetrathlon:** The Qualification period for Tetrathlon in 18 months from the 1st December 2019 to 1st June 2021.
- Dressage- a rider can only compete at one level of which they ride all three tests at that level eg Novice 2A, 2B, 2C so therefor there is no need to have them qualifying across split levels. A rider can nominate for more than one level eg Prelim and Novice or Novice and Elementary and if they choose to do so they will need to meet the criteria across both levels but they will only be selected to ride in one level.

PERFORMANCE DIARY

Riders from all sports are required to keep a Performance Diary that must be completed and submitted with the Nationals application to the Pony Club WA Office by 1st June 2021. You can download a Diary from the Nationals page on the Pony Club WA Website.

If you are applying for 2 disciplines, you will need to complete and submit a separate Performance Diary for each.

Tetrathlon will now be separate Male and Female competitions with teams of 4 riders of each gender, Teams will be 8 in each age group, 4 Male and 4 Female.

RIDE TO TIME
