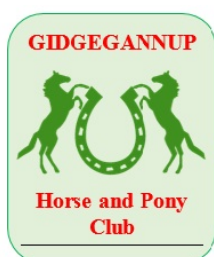

- Both thoroughbreds and standardbreds are available through the program, with prospective buyers matched with the most appropriate horse based on their level of experience and requirements.
- Prospective owners are able to try a horse multiple times to ensure they are the perfect match, with only one person viewing a horse at a time.
- All horses purchased through the program are up to date with dental, farriery, vaccinations, and deworming, and are registered for an Off the Track WA Passport and with the Australasian Animal Registry.
- Owners of horses purchased through the program become part of the Off the Track WA community, with ongoing support and advice, as well as 3x lesson vouchers with an Equestrian Australia accredited coach and 3x free entries to Off the Track WA clinics and events.
