As per the State Competition General Regulations

25 APPEALS COMMITTEE

25.1 The Appeals Committee is responsible for:

- i dealing with protests against decisions of the Technical Expert; and
- ii dealing with cases of infringements of any rules for which the Technical Expert is not responsible.

25.2 In carrying out its responsibilities the Appeals Committee may seek the advice of any person deemed appropriate and necessary to assist them in reaching a decision.

25.3 The composition of the Appeals Committee for each state competition shall be determined by the State Sport Committee or organising Taskforce, providing that the Appeals Committee shall consist of at least three people, all of whom have sufficient knowledge of the rules and processes relevant to Pony Club WA and that sport.

25.4 The following persons may not serve as a member of the Appeals Committee:

- i. the Technical Expert that made the decision that is the subject of the relevant protest and appeal;
- ii. any judges of the competition/class pertaining to the protest; and
- iii. any person with a conflict of interest

All competitors are to attend in their pony club riding uniform. Cross country shirts are acceptable.

Formal uniform is not required.

FOOD

CAMPING AND YARDS

Please put your manure and hay in the manure pits provided, do not leave it in heavy unmanageable bags or dump it under trees as this will kill the native trees. Please remove all hay from yards, fill in any holes and leave yards as you would be happy to find them.

If you are using your own portable yards they must be metal. Electric yards and steel pickets are prohibited.

COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINES & COVID-19 REFUND POLICY

AWARDS

PONY CLUB WA CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

- Rosettes to 6th for individual riders, saddle blankets for individual winners
- Rosettes to 3rd for team placings, rugs for the winning teams

Riders in the Championship Classes are eligible for the following special awards:

- Lucy Oorschot Trophy - for the female athlete with the highest combined run and swim score in the 95cm and 105cm Championship Classes.
- Highest scoring shooter (7m, 10m)
- Highest scoring swimmer (100m, 200m)
- Highest scoring runner (1000m, 2000m)
- Highest scoring rider (65cm, 80cm, 95-105cm)
- All thoroughbreds and standardbreds bred for the purpose of racing that compete in the Championship classes qualify for the Off the Track Award. When you entered the event you were asked to provide your horses' Passport details, race name and/or microchip.
- An Off the Track saddle blanket and rosette will be awarded to the best performed Off the Track horse in each of the Championship Classes. If there is an equality of riding scores, the closest to optimum time will be used to decide the award.



LUCY OORSCHOT TROPHY

The Lucy Oorschot Trophy is awarded in memory of one of our Tetrathlon competitors. The Trophy is awarded to the female competitor in the 90 and 105cm classes with the highest combined run and swim scores.

Tetrathlon was Lucy's favourite event as it combined three of her favourite sports, Running, Swimming and Riding. Lucy was a member of the Western Australian Tetrathlon team that won in 2013 at the Pony Club Nationals.

THE OFF THE TRACK WA PASSPORT IS HERE!

The Off the Track WA (OTTWA) Passport is designed to assist Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWWA) in tracing and connecting retired racehorses in WA, and gain a better understanding of their location and life after racing.

All owners of retired racehorses are encouraged to create an OTTWA Passport account and register the horses in their care.

In addition to supporting racehorses in the transition from racing to retirement, owners signing up their horses will be eligible for exclusive benefits, including access to OTTWA clinics and events, exclusive educational resources such as how-to videos and an OTTWA welcome pack.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR HORSES FOR A PASSPORT

1. Visit offthetrack.com.au and create an OTTWA Passport account.
2. Log in to your account, and search for your horse using its racing name, microchip number or other details known to you.
3. Once you find your horse, update its details and upload current photos of its brands.
4. Submit your application to RWWA for review, and allow up to two weeks for the application to be processed.
5. If approved, you will receive a printed version of your horse's ID Certificate. This can also be viewed on your online profile.
