EVENT INFORMATION

UNIFORM

Formal Pony Club Uniform is to be worn for all competitions (except Fancy Dress).

Leadline riders can wear their long sleeve rally shirt and cream/beige/white jodhpurs. Plaiting for Dressage and Showman is optional.

ENTRY AND QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

All Pony Club Rider entries are online via Ktrials www.ktrials.com.au

- The Festival Taskforce members do **not** have authority to accept/forward late entries.
- Entries must be completed correctly and in full.
- Entries must be paid in full when entering.
- All riders must have completed 2 Working rallies to be eligible to attend the Festival.
- The Rally Qualification Period is from 1 January 2021 to the 23 May 2021.
- After entries have been received, clubs will be sent a Club Entry Endorsement Spreadsheet for the riders from their club who have entered the Festival. This must be signed by their Club Chief Coach and Club President/Secretary.
- The one horse/one rider will apply for this event.
- Ready 2 Ride members are able to enter this event.

The organiser reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event
- To divide or combine any class
- To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- To alter the advertised times
- To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason

Neither the Organising Committee of the event to which these rules apply, nor Pony Club Western Australia Inc accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

HELPER DUTIES

- Helper duties will be via the online platform SignUp.
- You will be given the opportunity to select your own Helper Duty via SignUp.
- Each competitor must provide one helper (16 years and over) capable of performing any rostered duty.
- We reserve the right to re-allocate Helper Duties to suit operational requirements.
- One helper cannot be the designated helper for more than two competitors.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A **WWC Check** is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as 'child-related work' under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Events where the **usual duties** involve, or are they likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering at.

CANTEEN

Horsemen's Pony Club will be running a canteen during the event. A coffee van has been booked to be in attendance.

COVERED YARDS

Horsemen's Pony Club have limited covered yards available for hire at a cost of **\$10 each** for the weekend. Due to limited space, float yards are not able to be used. Please email secretary@horsemens.org.au to book a yard. Payments for yards are to be made directly to Horsemen's Pony Club & payment details will be provided by the Club.

CAMPING

Camping is available at a cost of **\$10 per family** for the weekend. A payment may be made on Ktrials for Camping. Hot showers are available at the grounds. Please make sure that all yards and camping areas are clean when you leave. All horse manure must be put in the manure pits.

COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINE & COVID-19 REFUND POLICY

Please make sure you sign in with the QR code placed at various locations around the grounds. Government guidelines concerning Covid-19 restrictions and precautions will be followed at all times. If you are having flu like symptoms and are unsure if you have Covid-19 please do not attend the event. A refund may be granted if you:

- test positive for Covid-19 and must isolate;
- are a close contact of someone with Covid-19 and must isolate;
- are showing symptoms;
- are isolating while awaiting PCR test results;
- are the care of someone in isolation

Members requesting a refund should provide supporting evidence to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au such as a medical certificate, PCR test result, photo of RAT result, text or email from Health Authorities, or other evidence confirming Covid-19 or need to isolate. Refunds may be subject to a \$10 administration fee.

PONY CLUB WA – NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of NO DOGS will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation

OFF THE TRACK

All thoroughbreds and standardbreds bred for the purpose of racing that compete in the Festival qualify for the Off the Track Award. When entering you will be asked to provide their Passport details, race name brands and/or microchip.

CALLING ALL VOLUNTEERS/ PARENT HELPERS

It is a condition of entry that each horse/rider combination provides a helper.

These events are not possible without parent helpers and we know younger riders need your help so if this is the case, please provide another helper to do your duty so the weekend can run smoothly.

THE OFF THE TRACK WA PASSPORT IS HERE!

The Off the Track WA (OTTWA) Passport is designed to assist Racing and Wagering Western Australia (RWAA) in tracing and connecting retired racehorses in WA, and gain a better understanding of their location and life after racing.

All owners of retired racehorses are encouraged to create an OTTWA Passport account and register the horses in their care.

In addition to supporting racehorses in the transition from racing to retirement, owners signing up their horses will be eligible for exclusive benefits, including access to OTTWA clinics and events, exclusive educational resources such as how-to videos and an OTTWA welcome pack.

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR HORSES FOR A PASSPORT

1. Visit offthetrack.com.au and create an OTTWA Passport account.
2. Log in to your account, and search for your horse using its racing name, microchip number or other details known to you.
3. Once you find your horse, update its details and upload current photos of its brands.
4. Submit your application to RWAA for review, and allow up to two weeks for the application to be processed.
5. If approved, you will receive a printed version of your horse's ID Certificate. This can also be viewed on your online profile.
