ABOUT

Running since 1975, the Pony Club WA Festival is an event, which provides opportunity for Pony Club riders to enjoy a full and varied event program. It is a informal weekend of riding compared to our State Championships. It is a great opportunity to try something a little bit different and have a huge amount of fun!

The 2022 Pony Club WA Festival is run in accordance with the Pony Club WA State General Competition Regulations.

GEAR CHECKING

As per the Current Gear Checking Manual

HORSES

Only the competitor competing on that day may school or exercise their horse or pony, including before and after the competition each day. If anyone other than the competitor is found riding the horse, the competitor will be eliminated

HELPER DUTIES

Have you 'Signed Up' for your Helper Duty?

You need to select your own Helper Duty – one per rider.

SignUp will open at 6:30am on Thursday, 2 June 2022.

Please note should you not select a Helper Duty per rider, we will allocate one to you. This might sound tough, however should people not turn up for their allocated Helper Duty, the whole Event will stop until the position is filled. We rely on our Volunteers - many hands make light work.

CLASHES

The timetable has been arranged to try to avoid a clash of events. However, if events do clash, riders must make their choice of events. Events will NOT be delayed for clashes and no refund can be given.

PRIZES

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place.

There will be a rug awarded for the High Point horse/rider combination in each age group.



DOGS

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of NO DOGS will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation

UNIFORM

Formal Pony Club Uniform is to be worn for all competitions (except Fancy Dress). Leadline riders can wear their long sleeve rally shirt and cream/beige/white jodhpurs. Plaiting for Dressage and Showman is optional.

CANTEEN

Horsemen's Pony Club will be running a canteen during the event. A coffee van has been booked to be in attendance.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A **WWC Check** is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as <u>child-related work</u> under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Championships where the **usual duties** involve, or are they likely to involve, <u>contact</u> with a <u>child</u>, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. A Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering.

COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINE & COVID-19 REFUND POLICY

Please make sure you sign in with the QR code placed at various locations around the grounds. Government guidelines concerning Covid-19 restrictions and precautions will be followed at all times. If you are having flu like symptoms and are unsure if you have Covid-19 please do not attend the event. A refund may be granted if you:

- test positive for Covid-19 and must isolate;
- are showing symptoms;
- are isolating while awaiting PCR test results;
- are the carer of someone in isolation

Members requesting a refund should provide supporting evidence to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au such as a medical certificate, PCR test result, photo of RAT result, text or email from Health Authorities, or other evidence confirming Covid-19 or need to isolate.

Refunds may be subject to a \$10 administration fee.



VENUE MAP






