Non-Jumping Alternative

Candidates selecting the non-jumping alternative are still required to jump a few obstacles with a height and width of 85cm.

HOWEVER if this is not achievable the following is required:

- 1. Candidates show their ability to jumping a horse
- 2. Candidate who has difficulty in the required height of 85cm, choose a sub stream that consists of the following
 - a) Candidate nominates the height and width they are comfortable with and prepare and train their horse accordingly for their assessment
 - b) Candidate design and construct the 2-3 fences they will jump, one of which is a spread fence—including a non-compulsory cross bar jump as a 'practice fence' and to encourage, a related line eg 5 strides (21m approx.) OR 6 strides (25m approx.) between two fences, as part of their '3 fence course'
 - c) Candidates jumping is videoed and this is discussed and reviewed with the Assessors and the candidate explains how they rode the fences and points for improvement
 - d) Candidate completes the dismounted section of the jumping requirements to demonstrate understanding of the horse and rider over a jump
