

VENUE

The Dardanup Horse and Pony Club was formed in 1997 when local families were unable to join the nearest pony club due to their lack of space to cater for more members. A meeting was organised by Jenny Trigwell to gauge interest in forming a local club. The response and interest were overwhelming, and the Dardanup Horse and Pony Club was formed.

Two rallies were held in 1997 at the Trigwell's property on Poad Road, Dardanup and, in 1998, the club moved to the Dardanup Equestrian Centre which was still in the process of being built. On the 10th of October 1999, the club's first gymkhana was held at the centre.



PONY CLUB WA - NO DOG POLICY

As this is a Pony Club WA event, no dogs are allowed on the grounds.



IMPORTANT NOTICES

Scoring for event

There will be 4 penalty points for knocking a rail Showjumping, 20 penalties for refusal Showjumping and 20 penalty points for refusal Cross Country Jump. All other penalties will be as per the 2022 Hickstead rules. Please Note: If you have 3 refusals at any 1 obstacle you will be asked to move on to the next obstacle.

RIDER

If a horse/pony refuses a show jump out on the country course and knocks a rail in doing so the jump will not be rebuilt the rider is to go around and will score 4 points for knockdown and 60 penalties.

If there is an A & B combination out on x country course (show jump or x country) and rider refuses the B or C element they can just represent to B or C go back and jump A but if they drop a rail or refuse this element then they will get the penalties that apply.

INDIVIDUAL WINNERS:

The individual winner in each class/age group will be the lowest penalties for combination but if a tie, it will go back to lowest dressage penalties, still a tie closest to optimum time in the x country/jumping phase

TEAM EVENT:

A team can be made up of 3 -4 horse/rider combinations. Only highest 3 scores will count. Team horse/rider combinations can be at any height and age (e.g., 3 x 30cm & 1 x 65cm or 1 at each height).

Lead line will not be included in this Team Event.

The Team winners will be the lowest penalties for combination but if a tie, it will go back to lowest dressage penalties, still a tie closest to optimum time in the x country/jumping phase.

HELPER DUTIES

All helpers must be over the age of 16 years and capable of performing the duty selected. Riders are required to supply 1 helper per horse/rider combination.

** If a rider scratches after the close of entries, they are still responsible to provide a helper on the day, or co-ordinate with their club to cover the helper duty.

INQUIRIES & PROTESTS

- Protests may be lodged against any person or body involved in any capacity in an Event or
 otherwise subject to the jurisdiction of Pony Club WA including for failure to observe the
 Constitution and By-Laws, Regulations or Rules or violation of the common principles of
 behaviour, fairness, or accepted standards of sportsmanship, whether occurring during or in
 connection with a Pony Club WA event or at any other time.
- 2. Any protest that concern processes or behaviours, rather than outcome or result of a competition, are a general complaint as outlined in the Pony Club WA Complaints Policy.
- 3. Only the owner or his authorized agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition or in a team event only the team manager is entitled to lodge an objection.
- 4. Protests must be in writing, signed by the person making the protest, and presented personally to the Event Secretary/ Technical Delegate/Steward together with any supporting evidence, names of witnesses and the necessary deposit of \$50.
- 5. Any person making a protest should, if possible, secure witnesses to the incident and any other form of evidence, and either brings them to the body before which the protest is lodged, or obtains written statements from them, duly signed, together with their names and addresses.
- 6. Any collection of evidence shall be in alignment with the Pony Club WA Member Protection Policy.
- 7. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, protests against any of the following matters may only be lodged with the Appeal Committee and within the following time limits, and a decision by the Hickstead Inspector/ Technical Delegate in these matters is a prerequisite to a right of appeal to the Appeal Committee:
 - 7.1 Protests concerning the eligibility of an Athlete or horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant competition.
 - 7.2 Protests concerning an obstacle, or the plan or length of the course for a jumping competition not later than 15 minutes before the start of the competition.
 - 7.3 Protests concerning cross country obstacles or courses in Hickstead not later than 6 pm on the day before the relevant competition.
 - 7.4 Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a competition, or the classification of a competition: not later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results or the posting of results on the event notice board. Protest Form Appendix C

Please note for the purpose of this document competition refers to a phase or class within an Event. REFUNDS

As per the Pony Club General Regulations page 4, section 10:

Where a rider withdraws in accordance with rule 9:

i all levies will be refunded in full; and

ii entry fees shall be refunded in full (less a 20% administration fee) by Pony Club WA in the following circumstance:

- a. where an entry is not accepted by Pony Club WA due to the total number of entries received exceeding the maximum capacity of the event/venue.
- b. where a rider withdraws prior to close of entries.
- c. where a Doctor's Certificate or a Veterinary Certificate is provided; or
- d. where a team or pair is no longer eligible to participate due to a withdrawal as outlined above and a replacement cannot be found.

Requests for refunds must be forwarded to the Pony Club WA Office on the prescribed form, together with the required certificate (if applicable), within seven days following the competition.

UNIFORMS

Formal club uniform for Dressage phase.

Jumping phase: long sleeve shirt in club colours.

Horse: For easy identification after a rider has been separated from their horse, a horse must carry its number either on the saddle cloth or the bridle in all phases.

Plaiting for the Dressage phase is optional.

Rider: For easy identification, competitors A4 size BIB numbers must always be worn by the rider when the horse is being ridden, exercised, or lunged and during all phases of the competition.

Numbers must be worn in front and on their backs.

Hair must be neatly restrained and long hair to be plaited to collar-length and restrained in such a way that the competitor number is visible from front and back.

Parents, grooms, etc. when lunging or exercising the horse/pony, must wear the competitors A4 size BIB number front and back. Helmet, boots, and gloves must also be worn whilst lunging.

BODY PROTECTORS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL HEIGHTS AND AGES IN THE JUMPING PHASE OF THE COMPETITION.


