Process for Candidate Assessment



Candidates register your interest to work towards completing your Certificate with Pony Club WA Office – development@ponyclubwa.asn.au.



Make payment of \$50 and the B Proficiency Manual will be sent to the Candidate



Recommend Candidate to attend the State and Zone Clinics



Candidate to work through Manual and complete requirements and journal



When Candidate feels confident, they have completed the requirements and reach the competency level they need to be prepared for assessment ran by an Accredited Coach at the level.



Candidates to complete the Application for B Assessment Form and forward to State Coaching Panel



State B Coordinator will appoint Assessors and organise the Assessment, State B Co-ordinator will liaise with Candidate all details of the day and prior requirements regarding submission of Journal, written paper and cost.



Candidate must successfully complete the following:

- Rider Journal and workbook
- Written Assessment (pass mark of 80%)
- On the Ground (groundwork and lungeing)
- Rider tool Kit
- Under Saddle; Flatwork, Showjumping and Cross Country
- Horse Management
