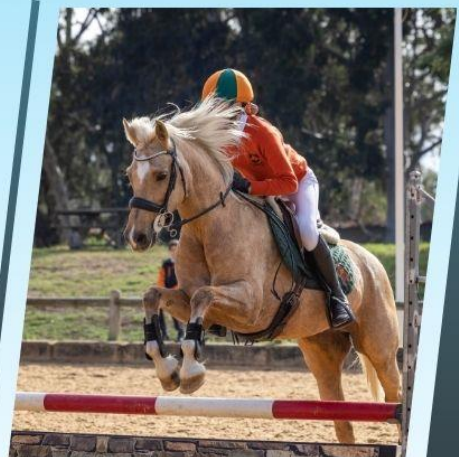

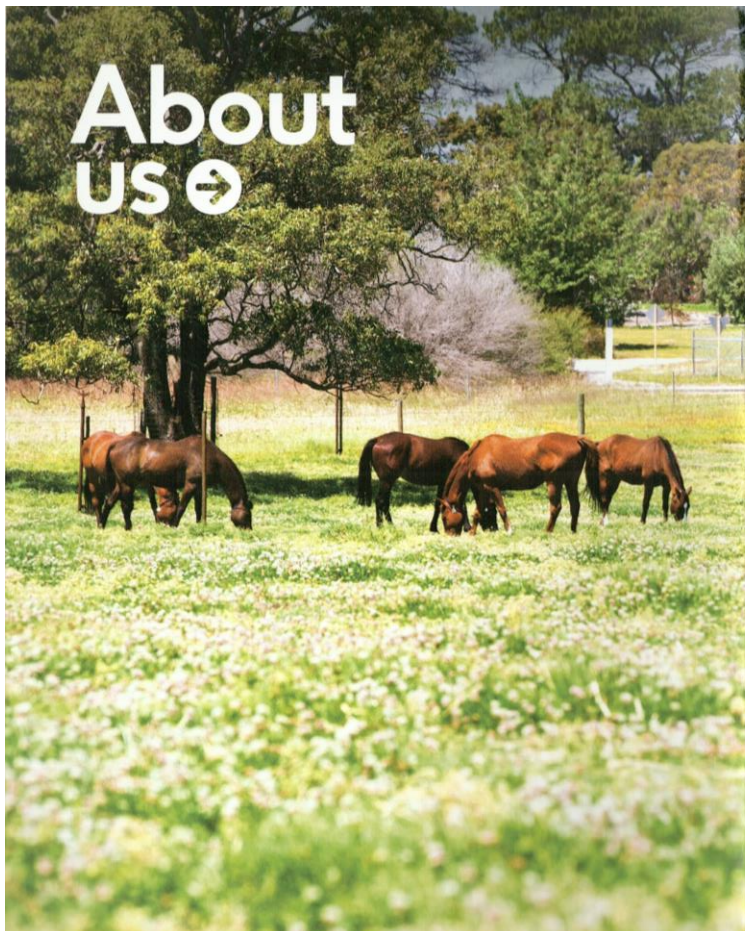

# STATE SHOWJUMPING CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

---

## STABLES AND CAMPING

All waste in stables and yards must be removed before leaving the event.

The State Equestrian Centre encourages people to secure their personal belongings.

Yards are available free of charge at Swan Valley Fields and Polo Fields.

Horses not booked in stables are not to be tied up in the stable area at any time.

If you are using a generator at this event, it must be Residual Current Device (RCD) protected and extension leads must be safety tagged.

## TIMETABLE CLASHES

Showjumping classes available are for Zone Teams, Club Teams and Individual Competitors.

In the event of a clash in the timetable, riders that have been selected in the Zone team must ride in the Zone class. If riders do not present on time, it may result in the elimination of the team.

The order of preference should be as follows:

Zone Teams	Club Teams	Individual Classes
------------	------------	--------------------

It is good etiquette to inform the arena marshals if you have a clash. Individual classes do not need to go in draw order, but a class cannot be held open for extended periods waiting for individuals to present. There will be no refunds if classes are missed.

## WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A **WWC Check** is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as child-related work under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Championships where the **usual duties** involve, or are they likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. A Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering.

## PONY CLUB WA – NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of **NO DOGS** will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation.

## ELECTRIC BIKES & E SCOOTERS

Electric Bikes and E Scooters are not permitted on the President's Lawn, General Purpose Grass Arenas or Stables during competition. This has been requested by the State Equestrian Centre Management

## VET ON CALL

A local Veterinary Officer will be on call throughout the Championships to provide services to injured or sick horses. Any veterinary expenses are the responsibility of the individual.

## COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINES & COVID-19 REFUND POLICY

Government guidelines concerning Covid-19 restrictions and precautions will be followed at all times. If you are having flu like symptoms and are unsure if you have Covid-19 please do not attend the event.

A **refund** may be granted if you:

- test positive for Covid-19 and must isolate;
- are a close contact of someone with Covid-19 and must isolate;
- are showing symptoms;
- are isolating while awaiting PCR test results;
- are the carer of someone in isolation;

Members requesting a refund should provide supporting evidence to [sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au](mailto:sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au) such as a medical certificate, PCR test result, photo of RAT result, text or email from Health Authorities, or other evidence confirming Covid-19 or need to isolate. Refunds may be subject to a \$10.00 administration fee.

## STABLES AND CAMPING

1. Generators must be Residual Current Device (RCD) protected and extension leads safety tagged.
2. All waste in stables and portable yards at the SEC and at Swan Valley fields, must be removed before leaving the event.
3. Please be aware, the SEC is open for anyone to come onto the grounds. We would encourage everyone to lock up floats, cars and secure any personal belongings.
4. The grass parking area on the right, as you enter the SEC, is preferable for overnight camping and would be appreciated by campers, if it was a horse free area. Yards are available free of charge at Swan Valley Fields.
5. Horses not booked in stables are not permitted to be tied up in the stable area at any time.

Please call **SEC Staff 0418 810 933** for any issues regarding stables, yards, and camping.

## FALL OF HORSE OR RIDER

Please note that under the EA Jumping rules (*and a Pony Club WA Showjumping rule*) in the event of a fall of a rider, medical clearance will be required before the rider can compete again during the Championships. This applies whether it be in the competition arena, warm up arena or anywhere on the grounds over the Championship weekend.

Similarly in the event of a fall of horse or pony, a veterinary certificate will be required before they can compete again. There will be no vet on course however there are vets on call listed following this. The costs for the veterinary assessment will be at the cost of the rider.



## SHOWJUMPING RULE CHANGES

*Please note:*

The only exception to the EA National Jumping Rules and FEI Rules for Showjumping are the Pony Club WA Showjumping speeds, as set out in the table below:

HEIGHT	SPEED (metres per minute)
105cm and above	325mpm
85cm to 105cm	325mpm
Up to and including 80cm	325mpm

## GEAR CHECKING

All saddlery must comply with the current Pony Club Australia National Gear Checking Rules.

Riders under the age of 18 years must present to the Gear Checker with a Parent or Guardian.

If you have a current Gear Exemption please show the Gear Checker your Gear Check Exemption credential from your profile in JustGo, or a screenshot of your Gear Check Exemption credential. Riders must be accompanied by the Team Manager for Gear Checking prior to the start of the Team and Zone competitions.

The Team Manager must **NOT** be riding in any activity on the day. **Teams presenting with a rider as their Team Manager will not be accepted.**

## CANCELLATIONS, SCRATCHINGS OR ALTERATIONS

If for any reason you wish to withdraw from a class during the event, please inform the Event office as soon as possible.

No entries on the day or swapping of classes will be permitted.

If you are withdrawing from a team, a form must be obtained from the event office and completed by the Team Manager. If your team has a duly qualified substitute, substitution forms will be available in the event office and must be completed by the Team Manager at least 30 minutes before the rider is scheduled to commence the class.

Substitutions must be made in writing and if within 24 hours of the class commencement, handed to the Event Secretary. These will be reviewed on a case by case and the SJ Committee decision is final.

No changing of rider order/heights is permitted at any time without approval from Event Secretary and must be made within 24 hours of the class commencement.

## FARRIER

There will NOT be an official farrier on the grounds or on call over the weekend.

## SWABBING

As from 1 January 2000, the Pony Club WA has adopted a policy of random swabbing. .  
Pony Club WA adheres to a policy of random swabbing at our State Championship events.

## PLAITING FOR BRIGID WOSS EQUITATION AND TEAM CHALLENGE

Plaiting is not mandatory but is expected for the Brigid Woss Equitation Team Event.

## HELPER DUTIES

It is the responsibility of all riders to supply a helper per horse/rider combination.

The Helper Duties were selected through SignUp

If you are needed to help your rider, please make sure that your rostered duty is always covered.

**Remember:** If a rider scratches after the close of entries, they are still responsible to provide a helper on the day or coordinate with your club to cover the rostered duty.

## PRESENTATIONS

Presentations for all team classes will be mounted and presented at the ring at the conclusion of the class. Placegetters in the Zone team classes should be in Zone uniform for presentations.

Placegetters for club and individual events should be in club uniform for presentations.

For individual Classes: Presentations will be at the conclusion of the class. Any additional prizes can be collected from the office, with the envelope received on the ring.

Rosettes not collected can be picked up at the Event Office.

## SHOWERS

The water in the showers in the indoor arena area are from electric storage hot water systems, so we would ask that you are mindful of how long you shower as a courtesy to those who follow you.

By being mindful of this will help everyone have a warm shower. There are also instantaneous showers at the Colts and Fillies before the entrance to Swan Valley Pony Club.

## DISPUTES

Disputes must be lodged by the Team Manager for teams or individual, on an official form, that is available from the office. This needs to be accompanied by \$50 and lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted.

The decision of the Ground Jury is final.

## WARM UP ARENAS

1. Respect must be shown to all officials and fellow competitors at all times.
2. Follow instructions from the Arena Supervisor at all times. Remember: Abuse of officials is a reportable offence.
3. Always consult the Arena Supervisor before entering the warm up arena.
4. Inform the Office and Marshal if you are scratching.
5. Inform the Office and Marshal if there is a rider change.
6. If there is any reason a rider wants to change draw order, you must report to the Office for approval.
7. Follow the published starting order.
8. There will be no more than 6 competitors in the warm up arena at any one time.
9. Only competitors involved in the current competition can use the warm up arena.
10. Replace all rails you knock down.
11. Warm up fences cannot be set more than 10cm higher and wider than the maximum dimensions for the current class.
12. Competitors to place warm up fences back to original height when finished.
13. The nearest horse to go on course has priority to use ONE warm up fence.
14. Do not return to the warm up arena after completing your round or if you have been eliminated.
15. Do not dismount and hold your horse in the warm up arena unless you are adjusting riding equipment/tack. In this case you must be clear of any jumps.

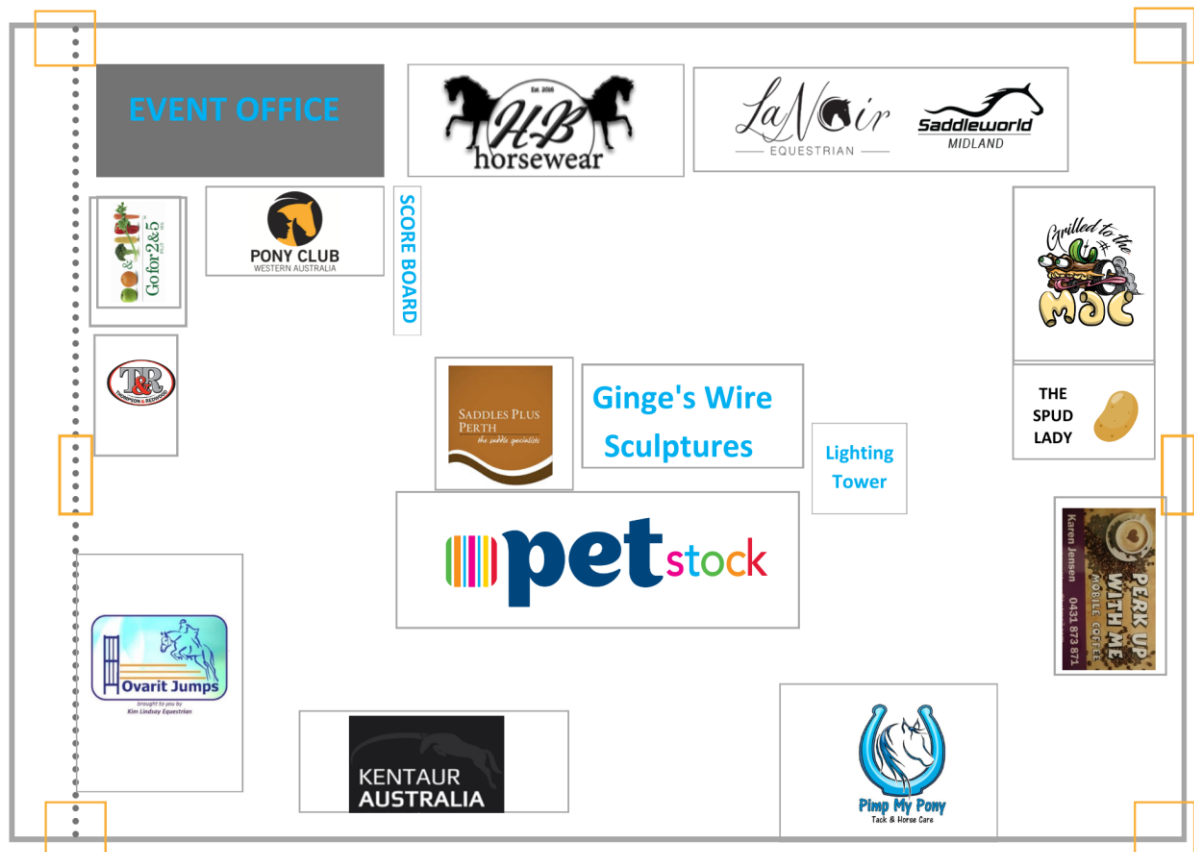

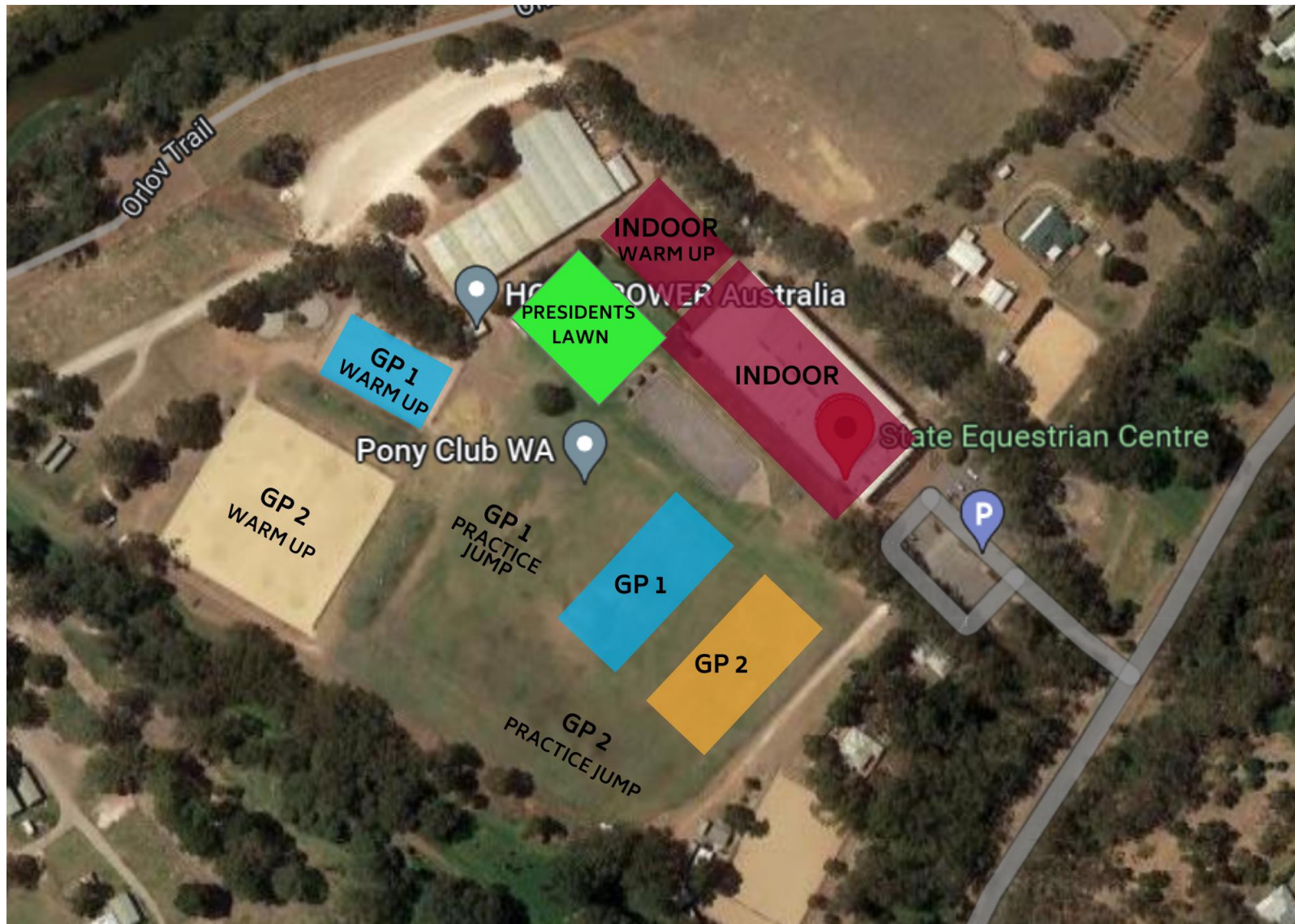
