







INFORMATION

- Please refer to the Reference Document for the VH Saddlery State Dressage Championships
- All entries are online via Nominate www.nominate.com.au and are completed by the individual rider. Entries close on Sunday, 11 June 2023 at 11pm. Riders must have a completed Club Endorsement prior to entering on Nominate to prevent the need to change and adjust entries.
- Each Club must submit a Dressage Championship Team Spreadsheet & Qualification Declaration.
 This must be endorsed by the Club President/Secretary and the Chief Coach/Coordinator and emailed to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au by Monday, 5 June 2023.
- Some classes have restricted numbers. Once the class is full, you may request to be added to a waiting list please email sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au.
- Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- The Rally Qualification period is from 11 June 2022 to 11 June 2023.
- The maximum number of tests/classes in a day is 3 per horse/rider combination.
- Plaiting is required at this event. It is optional for the Musical Ride, Formation Ride & Freestyles.
- In the spirit of the sport, if you have nominated on the Pony Club WA Leaderboard you must compete at those levels for the State Dressage Championships. If there are extenuating circumstances, you may apply to the Dressage Committee to change levels.

- Equestrian WA membership details will be checked with EWA. If you provide incorrect details your entry will be suspended until the matter is corrected and any additional fees are paid.
- The State Equestrian Centre Facility Levy & the Equestrian WA Ground Service Fee are collected by us on behalf of EWA.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The State Dressage Committee reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event.
- To amend placings offered dependant on class numbers.
- To divide any class.
- To transfer competitors between class.
- To alter the advertised times.
- To refuse any entry with a valid explanation.

HELPER DUTIES

- Helper duties are via the online platform SignUp. All riders will be emailed a list of the helper
 duties and a link to the SignUp page for them to select their own helper job. All helpers must be
 over the age of 16 years and capable of performing the duty selected. Riders are required to
 supply 1 helper per horse/rider combination.
- Clubs will be asked to provide the name and contact details of a Club Liaison Member to be a point
 of contact for the helper jobs for their Club during the event. If a rider scratches after the close of
 entries, they are still responsible to provide a helper on the day, or co-ordinate with their club to
 cover the helper duty.

FREESTYLE MUSIC SUBMISSION

Music must be submitted in MP3 format. An instruction video on how to upload your music is on the Dressage page of our website. Music must be submitted no later than **11pm**, **Sunday**, **11 June 2023**.

STATE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE INFORMATION

- Trade Stands and Food Vendors will be located on the President's Lawn during the event.
- Equestrian WA are currently reviewing the Stable Booking process. Once EWA finalise the booking
 process, we will advise riders via our newsletter and Facebook page. In the meantime, riders
 entering the Championships will be asked their intentions for Stable and Camping bookings via the
 online entry system.
- The State Equestrian Centre encourages people to secure their personal belongings.
- Yards are available free of charge at Swan Valley Fields.
- Horses not booked in stables are not to be tied up in the stable area at any time.
- All waste in stables and yards at the SEC and Swan Valley Fields must be removed before leaving.

PONY CLUB WA - NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of **NO DOGS** will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A WWC Check is required by a person if they engage in certain or unpaid work with children, described as child-related work under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at the VH Saddlery State Championships where the usual duties involve, or are likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. A Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering.

The State Dressage Committee is dedicated to the development and participation of riders in their sport.

This year the Pony Club WA State Dressage Committee will be providing 4 Bursaries to the VH Saddlery State Dressage Championship. Each of the above team events will have the opportunity to win a \$500 Bursary for their club where funds will go towards an accredited Dressage Instructor to conduct a clinic for the development of all club members.

Please note if awarded to a Composite team, the Bursary will be awarded to the club with the higher number of riders and the other rider (s) are to be invited to attend. There is no splitting of funds.

COMPOSITE TEAMS

Clubs who wish to apply to form a composite Nadine Merewether team and/or a Pas de Deux Elementary team must submit a request endorsed by the Club Chief Coach of each rider. Video footage must be submitted for consideration by the Dressage Committee.

For clubs that have a limited number of Elementary and above riders, and as a trial for this year's VH Saddlery State Dressage Championship, riders will have the opportunity to apply to the State Dressage Committee to make a combination with a rider from another club to form a composite pair. These riders, upon application must address the following criteria to be considered for an approved composite team.

Riders wishing to apply for a composite team must not have the option to create a pair within their own club before applying for a composite team.

When applying for a composite the club coach of each combination must sign off, and approve, the pair being submitted. Video footage of the two combinations riding together must be supplied showing the following movements:

- The combinations riding side by side at walk and trot
- The combinations crossing paths right rein to left rein at canter at either C or A (short side of the arena)
- The combinations crossing on a short diagonal at trot

After viewing the video footage, the State Dressage Committee will then decide as to whether the combination is approved as a pair and the applicants will be notified as soon as practical. Applications and video footage must be received prior to the close of entries for consideration.

COVID-19 EVENT GUIDELINES & REFUND POLICY

Government guidelines concerning Covid-19 restrictions and precautions will be followed at all times. If you are having flu like symptoms and are unsure if you have Covid-19 please do not attend the event. A refund may be granted if you:

- test positive for Covid-19 and must isolate.
- are a close contact of someone with Covid-19 and must isolate.
- are showing symptoms.
- are isolating while awaiting PCR test results.
- are the carer of someone in isolation.

Members requesting a refund should provide supporting evidence to sports@ponyclubwa.asn.au such as a medical certificate, PCR test result, photo of RAT result, text or email from Health Authorities, or other evidence confirming Covid-19 or need to isolate.


Refunds must be requested within 7 days of the event.

Refunds may be subject to a \$10 administration fee.

WARM UP ARENA ETIQUETTE

As there are many horses warming up in restricted areas it is important that all riders have knowledge of the etiquette required in a group situation. This ensures safe riding & achieves harmony in busy areas.

- Safety is paramount & a collision should always be avoided.
- Before entering the warm-up area, make sure the gateway & immediate track is clear.
- Riders should pass left shoulder to left shoulder when on the track.
- When not on the outside track, e.g., on a diagonal line, riders should give way to horses on their left.
- The more progressive gait has priority on the track.
- Halt should not be on the track.
- Walk should not be on the track & does not have right of way.
- Trot has priority over walk.
- Canter has priority over trot.
- Lateral work has priority over <u>all</u> paces.
- When circling, anticipate your return to the track to not stop the flow of other riders.
- Mounting, dismounting & gear adjustment should be done off the track.
- Consideration should be given to behaviour of other horses in the arena that may upset your horse.
- It may be necessary if your horse is upsetting others to leave the area.
- If a horse is upsetting the majority, an Official should be sought with a view to requesting that horse's removal for safety's sake.
- Horses are to be lunged in the designated lunging arena & the handler must wear an approved safety helmet, gloves, and footwear.
- Lower-level riders should not disturb the warm-up of higher-level riders.
- Coaches/Parents/Pedestrians must stay out of the warm-up areas to avoid injury.
- Coaching whilst in the warm-up arena must be from the sideline and must not disrupt other riders. The use of headsets is acceptable, but they must be removed prior to gear check.

The maximum number of entrants for these classes will be 40 competitors per class. If more than 35 entries per class, we will run Heat A and Heat B separately with the same Judge and in the same arena. In this instance, Ribbons to 6th place will be awarded to each Heat. Overall placings will be the two Heats combined and the scores ranked from highest to lowest.
