WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A WWC Check is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as child-related work under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at the Pony Club State Championships where the usual duties involve, or are likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking, Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a parent exemption applies. A Parent exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering

MEASURING

Measuring will be held with accredited measurers for both EWA and SHC on Friday 11 July from 8am to 10am. Cost is \$15 cash per measuring card paid by owners who present their horse / pony to the measuring bay. No EFTPOS facilities are available at the SEC.

The guidelines for measuring are available on both the EWA and SHCWA websites. Handlers must be 16 years and over in suitable footwear. Horses to be presented in a bridle unless young, un-mouthed stock.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The Pony Club WA and the State Dressage Committee reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event.
- To amend placings offered dependant on class numbers.
- To divide any class.
- To transfer competitors between classes.
- To alter the advertised times.
- To refuse any entry with or without an explanation.

HELPER DUTIES

- Helper duties are via the online platform SignUp. All riders will be emailed a list of the helper duties and a link to the SignUp page for them to select their own helper job. All helpers must be over the age of 16 years and capable of performing the duty selected. Riders are required to supply 1 x helper per horse/rider combination.
- Clubs will be asked to provide the name and contact details of a Club Liaison Member to be a point of contact for the helper jobs for their Club during the event. If a rider scratches after the close of entries,
- they are still responsible to provide a helper on the day, or co-ordinate with their club to cover the helper duty.

PROTESTS

Only the owner or his authorised agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition or in a team event, only the team manager is entitled to lodge an objection/protest.

Protests must be in writing on the prescribed form, signed by the person making the protest, and presented personally to the Event Secretary/Technical Delegate/Steward together with any supporting evidence, names of witnesses and the necessary deposit of \$50.

Any person making a protest should, if possible, secure witnesses to the incident and any other form of evidence, and either bring them to the body before which the protest is lodged, or obtain written statements from them, duly signed, together with their names and addresses. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, protests against any of the following matters may only be lodged with the Appeals Committee, and within the following time limits, and a decision by the Technical Delegate/Steward in these matters, is a prerequisite to a right of appeal to the Appeal Committee:

- Protests concerning the eligibility of an athlete or horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant competition.
- Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a competition, or the classification of a competition: not later than 30 minutes after the posting of results on the event notice board.

CLASHES

With the large number of entries and the riders in several classes, clashes between classes may occur. We ask for your understanding and co-operation.

CANCELLATIONS & SCRATCHINGS

Scratchings and/or any changes to entries must be **forwarded to the Club Team Manager** who will advise the Marshal's office or information desk.

No additional entries or alterations will be accepted on the day.

STATE EQUESTRIAN CENTRE INFORMATION

- Trade Stands and Food Vendors will be located on the President's Lawn during the event.
- Equestrian WA are continuing their new procedures for the Stable Booking process. Riders entering the Dressage Championships will book and pay for their Stable and Camping bookings via the online entry system.
- The State Equestrian Centre encourages people to secure their personal belongings.
- Yards are available free of charge at Swan Valley Fields.
- Horses not booked in stables are not to be tied up in the stable area at any time.
- All waste in stables and yards at the SEC and Swan Valley Fields must be removed before leaving.

PONY CLUB WA - NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of **NO DOGS** will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government, Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation.

REFUNDS

Members requesting a refund should provide supporting evidence such as a medical or vet certificate to <u>Jotform</u>. **Refunds must be requested within 7 days of the event**. Refunds may be subject to an administration fee.

SWABBING

Pony Club WA adheres to a policy of random swabbing at our State competitions.

STABLES AND CAMPING

- 1. Generators must be Residual Current Device (RCD) protected, and extension leads safety tagged.
- 2. All waste in stables and portable yards at the SEC and at Swan Valley Fields, must be removed before leaving the event.
- 3. Please be aware, the SEC is open for anyone to come onto the grounds. We would encourage everyone to lock up floats, cars and secure any personal belongings.
- 4. The grass parking area on the right, as you enter the SEC, is preferable for overnight camping and would be appreciated by campers, if it was a horse free area. Yards are available free of charge at Swan Valley Fields.
- 5. Horses not booked in stables are not permitted to be tied up in the stable area at any time.
- 6. Stable allocation is being coordinated via the Club Team Managers with the Committee any issues with Stables is to be coordinated via the Club Team Manager and Committee in the first instance.
- 7. Maps with stable allocation will be available at the end of each stable aisle for clarification.
- 8. Riders who are using a stable for only one day are to ensure that they clean their stable prior to another rider coming into the stable.
- 9. Due to the high turnover of horses in some stables it is recommend that a photo of the stable be taken prior to entering the stable, and post cleaning the stable to ensure bond are refunded.
- 10. No lungeing or warm up is permitted in any other area other than the designated areas.
- 11. Please call **SEC Staff** on **0418 810 933** for any issues regarding stables (other than allocation), yards, and camping.

PERFORMANCE MEDALS

The Pony Club WA Dressage Performance Medal program recognises horse and rider combinations who are achieving outstanding results throughout the competition year.

The committee envisaged that the Performance Medals recognition program would encourage riders to aspire to reach a higher standard of riding through dedication and training, and provide a measure of their personal achievements and success.

A Performance Medal can only be achieved once per level, that is a horse/rider combination can achieve 1 x Gold, 1 x Silver and 1 x Bronze medal per dressage competition level.
