All helpers must be a minimum of 16 years of age and capable of performing the duty selected.

Riders are required to supply 1 helper per horse/rider combination.

If a rider scratches after the close of entries, they are still responsible to provide a helper on the day, or co-ordinate with their club to cover the helper duty.

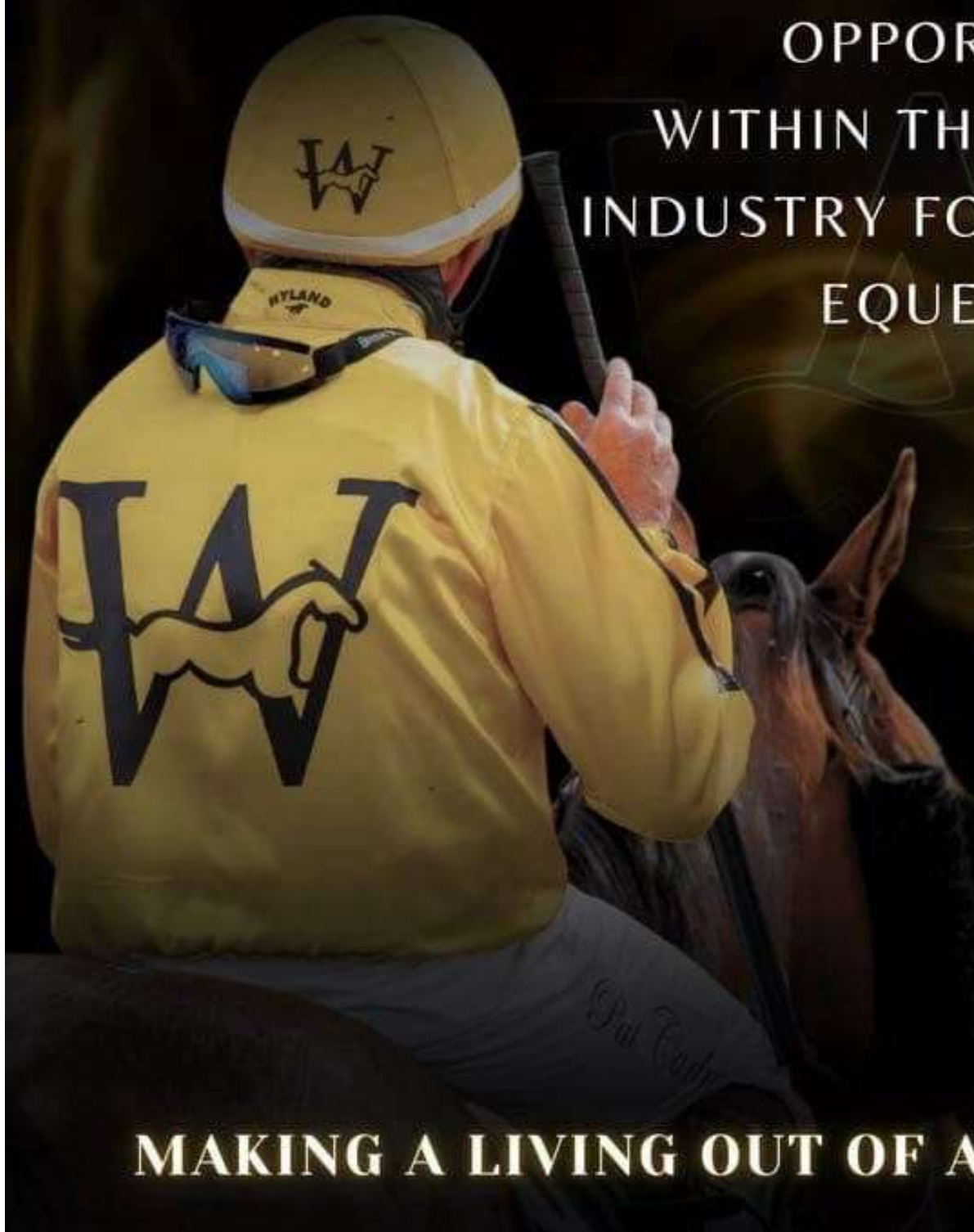

PONY CLUB WA – NO DOG POLICY

This is a Pony Club WA event, and the policy of NO DOGS will be strictly adhered to. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the elimination of rider(s). Assistance animals approved by the Department of Local Government; Sport & Cultural Industries are exempt from this rule. Persons with an Assistance Animal may be requested to provide their approval documentation.

SWABBING

Pony Club WA adheres to a policy of random swabbing at our State Competitions.

WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK

A WWC Check is required by a person if they engage in certain paid or unpaid work with children, described as child-related work under the WWC Act. Volunteers engaged in helper duties at Pony Club WA State Championships where the usual duties involve, or are they likely to involve, contact with a child, such as Team Manager, Gear Checking or Marshalling will be required to have a current WWCC unless a Parent Exemption applies. A Parent Exemption applies if you are volunteering and have a child under the age of 18 actively involved in the event you are volunteering at.

LEADLINE

Handler should be a minimum of 16 years of age and must be a member of Pony Club WA

CATERING

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

The Organising Committee reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event.
- To amend the placings awarded according to class numbers.
- To divide or combine any class.
- To transfer competitors between classes.
- To alter the advertised times.
- To refuse any entry with a valid explanation.

Neither the Organising Committee of the event to which these rules apply, nor Pony Club WA accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

UNIFORMS

Formal club uniform for Dressage phase. Jumping phase: long sleeve shirt in club colours.

Body Protectors (BETA Level 3) are mandatory for the Jumping phase of the competition.

Refer to Pony Club Australia National Gear Rules for full details.

Horse: For easy identification after a rider has been separated from their horse, a horse must carry its number either on the saddle cloth or the bridle in all phases.

Plaiting for the Dressage phase is optional.

Rider: For easy identification, competitors BIB numbers must always be worn by the rider when the horse is being ridden, exercised, or lunged and during all phases of the competition.

Numbers must be worn in front and on their backs. Bib numbers are A4 sizing and will be provided to riders at the competition on check in.

Hair must be neatly restrained and long hair to be plaited to collar to ensure that BIB number is visible from front and back. (Riders are not to have hair just in a ponytail)

Parents, grooms, etc. when lunging or exercising the horse/pony, must wear the competitors BIB number front and back. Helmet, boots, and gloves must also be worn whilst lunging.

BODY PROTECTORS ARE MANDATORY FOR ALL HEIGHTS AND AGES IN JUMPING PHASE OF THE COMPETITION

E SCOOTERS

Electric Bikes and E Scooters are not permitted in the stables, yards and competition arenas.

IMPORTANT NOTICES

Scoring for event

There will be 4 penalty points for knocking a rail Showjumping, 20 penalties for refusal Showjumping and 20 penalty points for refusal Cross Country Jump. All other penalties will be as per the 2022 Hickstead rules. Please Note: If you have 3 refusals at any 1 obstacle you will be asked to move on to the next obstacle.

RIDER

If a horse/pony refuses a show jump out on the country course and knocks a rail in doing so the jump will not be rebuilt the rider is to go around and will score 4 points for knockdown and 60 penalties.

If there is an A & B combination out on x country course (show jump or cross country) and rider refuses the B or C element they can just represent to B or C go back and jump A but if they drop a rail or refuse this element then they will get the penalties that apply.

INDIVIDUAL WINNERS

The individual winner in each class/age group will be the lowest penalties for combination but if a tie, it will go back to lowest dressage penalties, still a tie closest to optimum time in the x country/jumping phase

TEAM EVENT

A team can be made up of 3 -4 horse/rider combinations. Only highest 3 scores will count. Team horse/rider combinations can be at any height and age (e.g. 3 x 30cm & 1 x 65cm or 1 at each height).

Lead line will not be included in this Team Event.

The Team winners will be the lowest penalties for combination but if a tie, it will go back to lowest dressage penalties, still a tie closest to optimum time in the cross country/jumping phase.

QUERIES & PROTESTS

1. Protests may be lodged against any person or body involved in any capacity in an Event or otherwise subject to the jurisdiction of Pony Club WA including for failure to observe the Constitution and By-Laws, Regulations or Rules or violation of the common principles of behaviour, fairness, or accepted standards of sportsmanship, whether occurring during or in connection with a Pony Club WA event or at any other time.
2. Any protest that concerns processes or behaviours, rather than outcome or result of a competition, are a general complaint as outlined in the Pony Club WA Complaints Policy.
3. Only the owner or his authorized agent, or the rider of a horse taking part in the competition or, in a team event, only the team manager is entitled to lodge an objection.

4. Protests must be in writing, signed by the person making the protest, and presented personally to the Event Secretary/ Technical Delegate/Steward together with any supporting evidence, names of witnesses and the necessary deposit of \$50.
5. Any person making a protest should, if possible, secure witnesses to the incident and any other form of evidence, and either brings them to the body before which the protest is lodged, or obtains written statements from them, duly signed, together with their names and addresses.
6. Any collection of evidence shall be in alignment with the Pony Club WA Member Protection Policy.
7. Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, protests against any of the following matters may only be lodged with the Appeal Committee and, within the following time limits, a decision by the Hickstead Inspector/ Technical Delegate in these matters is a prerequisite to a right of appeal to the Appeal Committee:
 - 7.1 Protests concerning the eligibility of an Athlete or Horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant competition.
 - 7.2 Protests concerning an obstacle, or the plan or length of the course for a jumping competition: not later than 15 minutes before the start of the competition.
 - 7.3 Protests concerning cross country obstacles or courses in Hickstead: not later than 6 pm on the day before the relevant competition.
 - 7.4 Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a competition, or the classification of a competition: not later than 30 minutes after the announcement of the results or the posting of results on the event notice board. 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AWARDS

OFF THE TRACK

The winner will receive an Off the Track sublimated rug and rosette. Placings will be given from first to third.

These awards are made to eligible, registered Thoroughbred or Standardbred horses that compete in the Championship classes. All Thoroughbreds and Standardbreds who were bred for the purpose of racing qualify for the Off the Track Awards.



First to third place will be awarded to the horse/rider combination with the best performance (lowest penalties) over the whole competition. When entering you will be asked to provide the Passport details, racing name and/or microchip details
